

The German Shorthaired Pointer Club of SA hosted the 4th German Shorthaired Pointer National Show in Adelaide on 30, 31 August and 1 September 2002. The show comprised a Restricted Obedience Trial and a Conformation Show, with both conformation and property classes. German Shepherd Dog Club of South Australia's superb facilities at West Beach provided the venue. The use of marquees and colourful tents beside the ring gave the ground a truly carnival atmosphere.

The conformation classes were judged by FCI judge and President of the Hungarian Kennel Club, Mr Istvan Nagy. He attracted an entry of 187 Shorthairs from very state and territory in Australia. The classes judged included a competitive Veteran class and a State Bred class.

For his Best in Show, Mr Nagy chose Sandra Pert's liver and white Challenge bitch, Ch Heiderst Tia Maria Onice. Tia was exhibited in the Australian Bred class. She lives with her owner in Western Australia but was bred in South Australia by Raylene and Alex Smith and daughter Liat O'Malley. She is sired by Sonia Webb and Raylene Smith's Gr Ch Heiderst Cointreau Onice out of Raylene and Liat's Ch Heiderst Mad About You. Tia is related through her sire to the winner of the 1st GSP National held in Victoria in 1996, Ch Heiderst All That Style. Both dogs were sired by Raylene and Alex Smith's now deceased Ch Herstellerer Coco, bred by Diane Tennyenhuis.

For Runner-up to Best in Show, Mr Nagy chose his Challenge Dog, Zahleins Kennels' homebred Ch Zahleins Graff from New South Wales. Graff was also exhibited in the Australian Bred class so he also won Opposite Sex in Show. Graff was sired by now import Brox vom Bergsteiger (Imp Gmy) out of Zahleins Pearl. Pearl is related through her sire to Ch Herstellerer Coco, whose dam was Zahleins Odessa.

Reserve Challenge bitch was awarded to the litter sister of the Best in Show winner, Ch Heiderst Martini On Ice, owned by Rebecca and Margaret Bush from South Australia. Grace was exhibited in the State Bred class.

Reserve Challenge dog was the Open class winner, another South Australian dog, Ch Sevoier Makin Majic, owned and bred by Shannon Perkins with her sister Cherise Richardson. He is sired by Anne Raymond's English import, Ch Hillanhi Hakan (imp UK) out of Shannon's Ch Sevoier Cacherell.

Best Baby Puppy in Show went to the bitch, Edelfhof Yazmin, owned and bred by Diana and Jade Norman from Queensland. Yazmin is the progeny of 2 Australian Bred Grand Champions. Her sire is Gr Ch Heiderst Peer Gynt and her dam is Gr Ch Edelfhof The Tempe. Both parents are from English lines. Paris is sired by Ch Dorntanza Heidersts Piper (imp UK) and Tempe's dam is Walburg Quarda (imp UK).

Opposite Sex Baby Puppy was another Paris progeny, Sue Nicks Heiderst Lord Oth Realm, whose dam is English import Ch Dorntanza Lady of Spring (imp UK).

Best Minor Puppy in Show was Raylene Smith and Liat O'Malley's bitch, Heiderst Shawnee Sunset, whose dam is Gr Ch Heiderst Mohican Sunrise (ai). She is sired by Am & Mex Ch Pine Hill Early Riser (USA). Opposite Sex Minor Puppy was litter brother Heiderst War Drums owned by W Sim and G Teoh.

Best Puppy in Show was another Queenslander, Heather Reynold's homebred solid liver bitch, Tealpoint Game Getter. She is sired by Ch Tealpoint Dark N Stormy out of Ch Tealpoint Artemis NFD. Opposite Sex Puppy came from NSW, Pam Clarke and Christine Cunningham's Knusprig Justa Dye For.

Best Junior in Show was also from NSW, Lyn Nolan and Kylie Wright's solid liver bitch, Moruada Belle of the Ball. Portia's dam is English import, Ch Klugerhund Belle of Booton (ai) and her sire, Ch Moruada News Break, is also the grandsire of the Best Puppy, Ch Moruada News Break. Opposite Sex Junior was C & T Grandquist's Trupoint Fortyfourmagnum from Tasmania.

Best Intermediate in Show was a half sister to the Opposite Sex Junior, T Street's Ch Trupoint Xquisite Alli. Both dogs are out of Queensland bred Ch Zigeuner Q Tessin. Opposite Sex Intermediate was Ch Katydid Strongbow, bred in Western Australia but owned by Diana and Jade Norman in Queensland.

Best State Bred in Show was the Reserve Challenge bitch. Opposite Sex State Bred was Sandra Pert's liver and white dog, Ch Heiderst Navaho Warrior (ai). He is a
