The reach in movement was very impressive, in conjunction with very good stance, outline and hind angulation. The standard of dentition is something you should be very proud of. The bitches reflect the standard very well. You should be watchful of the size of your males and large framed dogs because of working concerns and the Australian weather conditions.

Now a little joke. We know that the horse comes from the dog. If you continue on this track perhaps you will breed horses. In Germany, we are coming back to the standard regarding correct size.

If I may say, it was a huge pleasure for me and my daughter (Saskia) to see and judge 126 dogs on one day.
